Southport Cheers to 30 Years

On Thursday, September 8th, the doors of Hangar 5 were open to reveal a beautifully refurbished CT-134 Musketeer aircraft alongside a 412 Outlaw and a G-120 Grob. The aircraft display provided a picturesque background to Southport Aerospace Centre's 30th Anniversary Celebration.

The 30th Anniversary Ceremony began with an Indigenous blessing and voluntary smudge by local Indigenous leaders, Darryl Taylor and Cornell Pashe.





The celebration continued with numerous guest speakers, all of whom spoke to the significant social and economic impact that Southport has had on the region and province over the last 30 years.

To commemorate this achievement and remind the community of the early years of flight training, Southport Board Chair, Doug McLennan, and Southport's Director of Development, Colby Orchard, announced that the newly renovated CT-134 Musketeer aircraft would be mounted on a pedestal in front of Central Plains RecPlex, along Centennaire Drive. Southport Aerospace Centre's Chief Executive Officer, Peggy May, was the final speaker of the event and she touched on Southport's past and future commitment to the Canadian Armed Forces.

"We certainly do have much to celebrate. Starting with Southport's rich history of military flight training. Southport provides a foundation where new pilots create a history with memories that will travel with them wherever they are called to serve. We look forward to providing a home for RCAF pilots for many years to come."

All guests were then asked to step foot onto the Southport Airport CYPG apron for a toast led by May and for a surprise fly by! Pilots, Colin Craddock and retired LCol, Stephen Bannister, gave guests a firsthand look at a Musketeer in flight as they did two passes past Hangar 5 before landing on the apron beside the identical Musketeer aircraft that will be memorialized onsite in Southport. Craddick, owner of the Restoration Hangar, is responsible for the impeccable refurbishment of the CT-134 Musketeer aircraft, a project that has been in the works for over a year.

Following the excitement airside, guests were invited to enjoy the rest of the celebration by taking photos alongside the aircraft as well as enjoying food and drink courtesy of Little Spruce Café.

Much has happened in Southport over the past few decades and the team at Southport Aerospace Centre, along and the community as a whole, are excited to see what the next decades will bring to the site of Southport!

Southport's Fun(d) Run

With great care, the Musketeer was lifted into the air and secured to the podium. The Musketeer is a great addition to the community and serves as a reminder of our history.
